Dear Mr. Roberto de Lucena, Congressman of Brazil, and Mrs. Vanessa Mendon ça, Secretary of Tourism of GDF,

We are writing to provide a letter of intent from China Electronic Chamber of Commerce – Esports Committee (CECC), and ASCENT SPORTS Inc. ("Ascent Sports") in respect of an opportunity to invest in a specific region of GDF for entertainment purposes in a Theme Park, with Esports and Technology Innovation (a "Transaction") with Governo do Distrito Federal Brasília, directly to your Secretariat of Tourism. ("GDF"). We appreciate the time and energy you and your team will afford us in discussing this opportunity and the information that has been provided thus far.

As we continue to spend time evaluating this opportunity, we believe that we will bring unique value and capabilities to the GDF, accelerating the development and growth of GDF THEME PARK. We believe we could drive Esports, Technology Innovation and other entertainment parts, growth strategy, by doing such research and technical study of the region.

### **Transaction Overview and Structure**

Based on our preliminary review of the information provided and subject to the conditions set forth below, CECC and ASCENT SPORTS is pleased to submit this non-binding letter of intent (the "Proposal") for a transaction with GDF. We propose to make future investments and/or bring new future investors for the equity of the Theme Park, including all assets and liabilities, in such a way that the THEME PARKE OF GDF still has significant exposure to future upside.

We believe that in order for this transaction to be successful our interests must be aligned. With that in mind, we have to visit the region and design a compensation structure that allows all parties to benefit from our future success in an equitable way.

### **Illustrative Timeline**

Given the importance of timing for GDF THEME PARK in respect to this transaction we have proposed a high-level timeline as follows:

- On future date: Operational due diligence and CECC and ASCENT SPORTS visit to GDF Region
- Date onward: Drafting of Project
- Date onward: Operational Possibilities and other meetings

### **Due Diligence Process**

This Transaction is of the highest priority for us, and we are prepared to proceed as quickly as possible; it is important that you make that same commitment to us before we expend additional time and resources pursuing this opportunity. CECC and ASCENT SPORTS has developed an opportunity project and timeline thesis and an understanding of the business through our initial due diligence, including several conversations with management, as well as a preliminary data review. We envision our remaining due diligence would include, but would not be limited to,

commercial, accounting, and financial due diligence, as well as customary legal, tax, and regulatory work if and after we get to a final conclusion and agreement of the viability of this THEME PARK. With the Company's full cooperation, we believe we can expeditiously complete our due diligence and present GDF THEME PARK with a definitive agreement once all the needed and proper steps are complied.

### **Exclusivity & Confidentiality**

If the GDF is interested in pursuing the proposed Transaction, we would require sixty months of exclusivity (the "Exclusivity Period") to finalize our due diligence and negotiate definitive project and other technical details from your side and our side, subject to a 60-day extension if CECC and ASCENT SPORTS is working in good faith to consummate the transaction at the initial expiration date. In light of our Proposal's premium valuation, we believe that granting exclusivity at this stage will benefit the Project and its Shareholders. In order to complete our due diligence and to secure the additional requisite capital, we will need reasonable access to GDF information and the ability to share that information with our prospective equity partners and debt financing sources in a manner that protects the confidentiality of your information and our discussions. A draft form of the exclusivity and confidentiality agreement can be is enclosed to this letter in future time, as Exhibit A for your consideration (the "Exclusivity and Confidentiality Agreement"). We emphasize our desire to complete the proposed Transaction in an expeditious and efficient manner and our readiness to mobilize resources to move ahead quickly. To that end, and assuming we sign this letter in advance, we would suggest an organizational meeting as soon as possible to agree on the work plan during the Exclusivity Period.

Subject to the immediately following sentence, none of the parties shall be bound in any way in connection with this letter unless and until the parties execute a definitive agreement, and then shall be bound only in accordance with the terms of such agreement. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this letter, the Exclusivity and Confidentiality Agreement, once executed by the parties thereto, shall constitute binding obligations of the parties thereto.

We are very excited about the potential opportunity and hope that you are equally interested in proceeding in a constructive and expeditious dialogue. We look forward to working with you to complete this transaction.
